Application of James Back No. 5751

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempted Second Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th day of November, A. D. 1931, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable James A. Hall presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 10 years imprisonment and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Allen G. Thompson prosecuted the case.
