Application of Miles DeWitt #4929

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 3rd Degree

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 23rd day of November,
A. D. 1927, at ~~Richfield~~ Junction County of Piute,
and State of Utah, in the Sixth Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Naphi J. Bates presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from six months to
three years,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth--Honorable Henry E. Beal prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Miles DeWitt
I was convicted under the name of Miles DeWitt

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Auer Peterson.

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
