Application of Willis Larsen

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery (I pleaded Guilty)

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of December,
A. D. 1929, at Manti, County of Sanpete
and State of Utah, in the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Dilworth Wooley, presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence of from one to
twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-Honorable There was no one F. W. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Willis Larsen

I was convicted under the name of Willis Larsen

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Young Hayes of Ogden, who was sentenced with me, and
Harry Christiansen of Centerfield, not yet in the District court.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except (None).
I did not understand that I was guilty of forgery when I pleaded
guilty, and do not believe that the offense was forgery, but a fraud-
ulent check. I had no one to speak for me or advise me at the time.
