Application of Willis G. Larsen,

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows: on parole

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the state prison, under parols,  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 12th day of November,  
A. D. 1929, at Manti, County of Sanpete  
and State of Utah, in the seventh  
judicial district Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Wooley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah state prison thirty eight days

and district atty  
Fourth-Honorable C.M. Edwards, county atty, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Willis G. Larsen  
I was convicted under the name of same

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Ezra Hayes, Harry Christiansen

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except this one.
