I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION OF SENTENCE and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in UTAH STATE PRISON under conviction and a sentence on a charge of *Grand Larceny* LARCENY FROM A PERSON

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 8th day of JUNE A. D. 1929, at ODGEN County of WEBER and State of Utah, in SECOND DISTRICT Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable JUDGE GEORGE BARKER presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to ONE TO TEN YEARS and thereafter was imprisoned in the UTAH STATE PRISON

Fourth-Honorable DAVIS J. WILSON prosecuted the case.
