To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of assault with intent to
commit murder

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 17th day of June
A. D. 1925, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in 2nd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to five years to life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is William Elmer Shoults
I was convicted under the name of Same as above

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None
