Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Eight day of June
A. D. 1925, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in 2nd Judicial Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Geo. S. Beebe presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Five years to Life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is William Elmer Shauls
I was convicted under the name of William Elmer Shauls

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
