First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault to commit murder

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 8th day of June
A. D. 1925, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second District Court Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Five years to life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Jos. C. Evans prosecuted the case.
