Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 2nd day of January,

and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Chris Matheson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Ernest E. Slone.
I was convicted under the name of Ernest E. Slone.
