Application of E. E. Slone No. 1947

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination of Sentence
(to leave State)
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Indecent Assault

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 3rd day of January,
A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Ernest E. Slone.
I was convicted under the name of same

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
