Application of Caroline W. Rouch

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Carnal Knowledge.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 20th day of October
A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of S. L.
and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable William S. Marks presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Caroline Alfred Rouch
I was convicted under the name of Caroline W. Rouch

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: J. L. Howell, Jack Steen, Richard Larson,
James Johnson, Pete Kiser, Floyd Hawkins and two others

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except U.S. Disciplinary
Board's Alcatraz Island Calif. In Dec 1919 from
U.S. Army
