Application of John Harley

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree burglary.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 23rd day of November A. D. 1926, at Parowan County of Iron and State of Utah, in Sixth judicial district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Nephi T. Bates presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term not to exceed twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable J. T. Luntz prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John Harley
I was convicted under the name of John Harley.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none.
