Application of JAMES LEWIS No. 4947

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION OF SENTENCE and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in THE UTAH STATE PRISON under conviction and a sentence on a charge of GRAND LARCENY

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 23d day of DECEMBER A. D. 1927, at OGDEN County of WEBER and State of Utah, in THE SECOND DISTRICT Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable JUDGE J. H. KIMBALL presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to ONE TO TEN YEARS

and thereafter was imprisoned in the UTAH STATE PENITENTIARY

Fourth-Honorable CHARLES E. EVANS prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is JAMES LEWIS

I was convicted under the name of JAMES LEWIS

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: DELIA MARSHALL

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except THE ONE FOR WHICH I AM NOW INCARCERATED, AND A CHARGE OF ATTEMPTED GRAND LARCENY IN THE STATE OF WASHINGTON.
