Application of JAMES LEWIS No. 4943

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in THE UTAH STATE PRISON under conviction and a sentence on a charge of GRAND LARCENY

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of DECEMBER A. D. 1927, at OGDEN County of WEBER and State of Utah, in THE SECOND JUDICIAL DISTRICT Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable JUDGE KIMBALL presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to ONE TO TEN YEARS and thereafter was imprisoned in the UTAH STATE PRISON

Fourth--Honorable JOSEPH E. EVANS prosecuted the case.


Fifth--My true name in full is JAMES WARD
