Application of A. Domingus No. 4998

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 3rd Degree.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of March A. D. 1928, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in the Second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to six months to three years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
