Application of R H McCoy

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in State Penitentiary
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder in the 1st Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14 day of March
A. D. 1925, at Farmington County of Davis
and State of Utah, in the District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. P. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Life imprisonment
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison
Salt Lake City

Fourth-- Honorable Geo. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Robert Harry McCoy
I was convicted under the name of Robt Harry McCoy

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Archie Wilcox

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except at the same
time I pleaded guilty to Bank Robbery and
was sentenced to a term in the
State Penitentiary from 5 years to life with
term I am now serving simultaneously
with the life term for Murder
