Application of Robert H. McCoy

On the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation and Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder and Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 20th day of December, A. D. 1924, at Bountiful, Utah County of Davis and State of Utah, in the Second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimball presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Jos. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Robert H. McCoy

I was convicted under the name of Robert H. McCoy

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Archie Wilcox.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
