Application of James J. King No. 4185

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 8th day of January, A. D. 1923, at Ogden, Utah County of Weber and State of Utah, in the Second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Joseph E. Evans, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is James J. King

I was convicted under the name of James J. King

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except that shown on records.
