Application of James Jerome King. No. 4185

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination leave state and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Highway Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 5 day of January A. D. 1923, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence of from five years to life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Joseph E. Evans, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is James Jerome King. I was convicted under the name of James Jerome King.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as shown on prison record
