Application of James Jerome King No. 5448

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 20 day of Aug A. D. 1930, at Idaho County of Heber and State of Utah, in Second Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Ernest Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to five years to life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Dist. Atty. D. J. Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is James Jerome King I was convicted under the name of " " "

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Arthur J. ...

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as avarice Shuns
