First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I ~~was convicted~~ ^{pleaded guilty} and sentenced on the 29th day of Aug. A. D. 1927, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in 2nd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimball presiding.
