under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 28th day of Aug.
A. D. 1927, at Odgen County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge J. N. Kimball presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Seven indeterminate sentence
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Gene Enigh

I was convicted under the name of Gene Barton
