Application of Gene Barton No. 4896

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Unadulterated Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 29th day of August
A. D. 1927, at Odgen County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge J. N. Kimball presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve not less than
five years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Gene Emigh

I was convicted under the name of Gene Barton

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: none

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except none
