Application of Philip Weathersbee No. 5093

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison, under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th day of November, A. D. 1928, at Ogden, Utah County of Weber and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Geo. S. Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Jos. E. Evans, prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Philip Weathersbee. I was convicted under the name of Same.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except.
