First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah state prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th day of November
A. D. 1928, at Cogdoy County of Weber
and State of Utah, in 2nd district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Geo. S. Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 5 years to life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State prison

Fourth-Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Phillip Weathersbee
I was convicted under the name of Phillip Weathersbee
