Application of Philip Weathersbee No. 5093

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 15th day of November  
A. D. 1928, at Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge George S. Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Five Years to Life  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Philip Weathersbee  
I was convicted under the name of Philip Weathersbee
