Application of Stanley Bueter

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Carnal Knowledge

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of March A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in The Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to The State Prison on the 5th day of March 1927 to an indeterminate term with the recommendation of six month from both the judge, L. B. White and Assistant District attorney, Samuel G. Clawson. and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison on the 9th day of March 1927.

Fourth-- Honorable Samuel G. Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Stanley Bueter I was convicted under the name of Stanley Bueter

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Joe Heather and E. La Mont

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except assault and battery.
