Application of Donald Teeter

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 24th day of December A. D. 1927, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in the Seventh District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an Indeterminate term of from one to twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison at Sugar House.

Fourth-- Honorable Fred W. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Donald Teeter I was convicted under the name of Donald Teeter

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: There are no persons connected with this offense.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.

I want to state my reasons, if possible, before your honorable body and if impossible wish to state that I am desirous of leaving this state and of returning to Garrison, N.C. my home.
