Application of Donald Teeter No. 4942

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 24th day of December A. D. 1927, at Price, Utah County of Carbon and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Twenty Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable F. W. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Donald Teeter I was convicted under the name of Donald Teeter

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Charles W. Wilson (Paroled June 16th 1928)

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except NONE
