I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ^{Conditional} Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 2nd Degree.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of February A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
