I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination (On the Conditions that I go to Tacoma, Washington. Where, I have Work) and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 12th day of April A. D. 1924, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Five Years to Life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is James Lenzi I was convicted under the name of Thomas Moore
