First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 2nd Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 13th day of April
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Wesley Walkenshaw
I was convicted under the name of Wesley Walkenshaw

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: James Banks.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
