Application of J. W. Kingston

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 12th day of July A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one to twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable A. A. Duncan prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Norman Edward Dunbar I was convicted under the name of J. W. Kingston

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None
