Application of George Leonard Clayton #4988

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Depriving Owner of Vehicle

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 29th day of February, A. D. 1928, at Ogden, County of Weber and State of Utah, in the Second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Jos. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is George Leonard Clayton I was convicted under the name of George Leonard Clayton

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
