and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Seventh day of May
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. B. Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Twenty Years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable A. A. Duncan prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Billy Mitchell
I was convicted under the name of Billy Mitchell

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows:

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Felony
