and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison.
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery.

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the seventh day of May, 1927.
A. D., at Salt Lake City, Utah. County of Salt Lake.
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Wright presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to serve an indeterminate sentence of from
one to twenty years.
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth--Honorable Duncan. prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Billy Mitchell.
I was convicted under the name of Billy Mitchell.

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: None.

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except as record shows.
