and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 7 day of May
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. B. Wight presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable A. A. Duncan prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Billy Mitchell
I was convicted under the name of Billy Mitchell
