First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of November A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wright presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison
