Application of JOE DAVIS No.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in County Jail under conviction and a sentence on a charge of petit larceny.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of September A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake, and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Oscar W. McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve six months in the County Jail of Salt Lake County, State of Utah, and thereafter was imprisoned in the said Salt Lake County Jail.

Fourth-Honorable Calvin W. Rawlins, Assistant District Attorney prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is JOE DAVIS I was convicted under the name of JOE DAVIS

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: my wife, Fannia Davis

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except intoxication.
