Application of John Randolph No. 4770

On the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 25th day of October A. D. 1926, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in The Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable James Kimball presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Five Years to Life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Joseph C. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is John Randolph I was convicted under the name of John Randolph
