Application of Gust. Lambru #4925

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination (Conditional) and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of November, A. D. 1927, at Ogden, Utah County of Weber and State of Utah, in the Second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker, presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.
