I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a final release
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Parol
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 29th day of June
A. D. 1923, at Salt Lake County of Salt
and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to from one to two years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison for nine
months and was punished on a good
behavior.

Fourth-- Honorable Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Peter S. Reed.
I was convicted under the name of J. S. Clarke.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: none.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except
I have worked and lived right
all the time I have been on
Parol. I would certainly like a
final release, because I expect
to get married.
