First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of January, A. D. 1928, at Provo County of Utah and State of Utah, in Fourth District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Larson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Millard W. Ralls I was convicted under the name of same as above

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except as above
