Application of Charles Heney

On the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the fifth day of February
A. D. 1927, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable James W. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to from one to twenty years,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Charles Bernard Haney
I was convicted under the name of Charles Heney
