First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in S. L. County Jail under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Practicing Med. w/o License

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of December A. D. 1935, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in City & County Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. M. Bronson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Serve Six Mo in S. L. C Jail and thereafter was imprisoned in the Said County Jail

Fourth-Honorable Ray Vincent prosecuted the case.
