To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 2nd Degree.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the thirteenth day of November  
A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Chris Mathison presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Twenty Years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Samuel G. Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Albert Jensen.

I was convicted under the name of Albert Jensen.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Burglary.
