Application of Albert Jensen No. 4777

and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 2nd Degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 13 day of November
A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Chris Mathison presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Indeterminate Term

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Samuel G. Clawson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Albert Jensen

I was convicted under the name of Albert Jensen

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows:

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Burglary
