First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of First Degree Murder

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 22nd day of March A. D. 1924, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Life Imprisonment and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Fred W. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is E.F. Lopez I was convicted under the name of E.F. Lopez

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None
