Application of E. F. LOPEZ No. 4360

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION OF SENTENCE and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in THE UTAH STATE PRISON under conviction and a sentence on a charge of MURDER 1st DEGREE

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 22nd day of MARCH A. D. 1924, at PRICE County of CARBON and State of Utah, in THE SEVENTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable GEORGE CHRISTENSEN presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to LIFE; COMMUTED TO TWENTY FIVE YEARS ON MAY 21, 1932, and thereafter was imprisoned in the UTAH STATE PRISON.

Fourth-Honorable FRED W. KELLER prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is E. F. LOPEZ I was convicted under the name of E. F. LOPEZ

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: NONE.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except NONE.
