Application of Noah Pritchard

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination of Sentence, and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Indecent Assault.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16th day of July, A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City County of Tooele and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from 1 to 5 years, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable A. A. Duncan prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Noah Pritchard

I was convicted under the name of Noah Pritchard

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.
